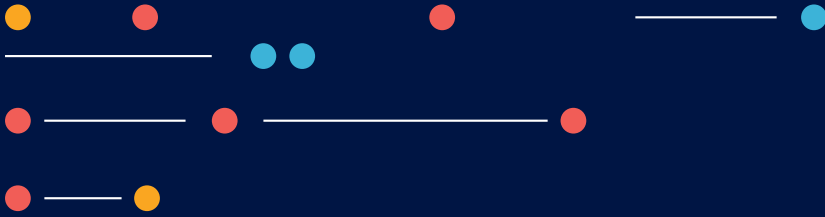




# Ride Metro Micro™ with your kids.



Metro Micro is available to everyone! We want all our riders safe on Metro Micro.



## Age

13 & OVER	5 TO 12	4 & UNDER
Kids this age can ride Metro Micro unaccompanied. As a parent, it is up to you to determine if your teen is ready to ride alone.	Kids this age can ride with a caregiver at the regular fare. Car seat or booster required for children who need it (see more information below).	Kids this age can ride with a caregiver for free. Choose the "PCA/Child" passenger type for them when booking.

## Child Restraint Systems (CRS) – Also Known As Boosters and Car Seats

Unlike buses, Metro Micro vehicles are vans and must comply with the same child transport regulations as personal vehicles.

*California law says:*

**CHILDREN UNDER 8 MUST ride in an appropriate booster or car seat.** What does “appropriate” mean? An appropriate seat is one that is not damaged; fits your child by weight, height and age; and that you and your child can use correctly every time for the entire trip.

**CHILDREN UNDER 2 MUST ride rear-facing in a seat designed for rear-facing.**

**ALL CHILDREN MUST** be “properly secured ... in an appropriate child passenger restraint system or safety belt meeting applicable federal motor vehicle safety standards.” (CA vehicle code 27360.5) If your child age 8 and over needs a booster to fit the seat belt correctly, they need one to ride Metro Micro.

## Bring Your Own

At this time, Metro Micro does not provide car seats or boosters. Please bring an appropriate car seat or booster for your child passenger, and be prepared to install it when you board.
